Game Cancellation Policy

All scheduled games are to be played on the assigned date and time as per the schedule provided by the WCBL. Games are only to be rescheduled due to inclement weather, resulting in school closings, early dismissal, or cancellation of after school activities, causing most schools in the WCBL to close.

If league cancels games due to weather and game is played, it will not count and must be rescheduled.

Game cancellations on Saturday following a Friday cancellation will be at discretion of town coordinator. Town coordinator and coaches need to communicate with each other via phone.

Seeding for the tournament will be based on the first (9) nine played games. If a team does not play nine games, the tournament coordinator and WCBL Officers will evaluate the circumstances and determine playoff eligibility.

In the event of inclement weather resulting in a school closing, or cancellation of after school activities, the game is to be rescheduled. When a game is cancelled, the home coach must notify their town coordinator, who will notify the referee(s).

With regard to game cancellation, if a home coach does not make an attempt to reschedule, the home team takes a forfeit. If the home coach contacts the visiting coach, and the visiting coach does not respond to rescheduling attempts, the visiting team takes a forfeit. Rescheduling of cancelled games must be completed within seven (7) days of the original game date. In the event the game is the final game for seeding purposes, this game must be rescheduled and played ASAP.

The home coach must contact their town representative to obtain gymnasium availability, and coordinate rescheduling of the game with the visiting coach. The town representative of the home gymnasium must contact the referee coordinator to schedule referee(s).
